



CID COVID Exposure or Positive Test Policy

CID is a Youth Protection Advocates® in Dance Certified Studio. Additionally, we follow the More Than Just Great Dancing!® After Studio™ Guidelines which prioritize keeping sick people home, hand hygiene, facility cleaning and curricular adaptations to reduce mixing and mingling. We also follow all Maricopa County Health Department recommendations for assembly sizes, staff mask-wearing (with some exceptions), and social distancing.

Additionally, we have made our own adaptations to classes to allow for private and semi-private instruction in addition to traditional classes. Online classes and pre-recorded classes will also be available in the event a child is not able to attend physical classes.

As our region re-opens and testing capacity grows, reports of known exposure to COVID-19 and positive test results will increase as well. That said, we WILL have reports of exposure and positive cases in our studio - as will schools, daycares, and other youth-serving activities. That's why we have taken proactive steps to communicate with the Maricopa County Health Department to develop the following guidelines for reports of COVID-19 exposure and positive tests.

#1 - If a parent calls to report their child has known exposure or has tested positive for COVID-19, two things will happen:

- a. **REPORTING** - They will be asked to share their report with their county health department. The studio will share a report via email with their class that a known exposure or positive case has been reported.
- b. **CLEANING** - The studio will activate a Level 3 cleaning of the facility. For reference, normal daily cleaning is Level 1. Our current cleaning is Level 2 - which includes sanitizing high touch surfaces between classes. Level 3 cleaning includes a deep cleaning of all touchable surfaces.

#2 - At that point, it will be the parent's choice whether or not they are comfortable attending class or whether they would prefer to take a class online for a week or two.

#3 - Please note that CID has established with the Maricopa County Health Department our COVID-19 Report Response Plan for Reporting and Cleaning and will not be closing the entire studio for single reports of COVID-19 or positive tests. CID will continue to work with the Maricopa County Health Department on a case by case basis and will follow all recommendations for potential closure in the event of any cluster reports.
